<b>Monday -Thursday Schedule</b>		
Kindergarten -Morning Classes	Class Starts at: 9:00 am.	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—60 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher.
All Kindergarten Classes	10:30 am	PREP Classes (Optional)
Kindergarten- Afternoon Class	Class Starts at: 12:30	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—60 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher

<b>Monday-Thursday Schedule</b>	
<b>Grades First-Fourth</b>	
Class Starts at: 9:00	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—120 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher.
11:15-12:00	PREP Classes (Optional)
12:00-12:30	Lunch Break
1:00-1:30	Independent Learning: ie, i-Ready Reading, ST Math, Imagine Math

<b>Grades Fifth and Sixth</b>	
Classes start at 9:00-12:00	Classes via Team/Zoom and Canvas under the direction of the teachers –180 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher.
12:00-12:30	Lunch Break
12:30-1:15	PREP Classes (Optional)
1:15-1:45	Independent Learning

- Teachers will communicate the format and times to you on a class by class basis. Teachers will also post times they can respond to you or your students if you need assistance. Students have been using Canvas in class, as well as the assigned programs. We are confident that they will have the skills to navigate this system.
- If you need your students i-Pad or if there are learning components that involve paper/pencil tasks, the school office will help assist with delivery or pickup of material for quarantined students.
- Fridays will continue to be independent learning days on Canvas with individual and small group sessions via Teams/Zoom, as guided by teachers.
- Classroom teachers will work with Mrs. Egbert and other related servers to make sure that students with IEP's are getting their service times.
